Dear Parents:

We are beginning the last month of school for this year. However, we still have a few activities and the final exams.

Last day for uniforms is Friday, June 9th. If students do not wear respectable clothes, they will be required to wear their uniform the rest of the year. SHORTS MUST BE AT THE KNEES AND NO TANK TOPS OR FLIP FLOPS. On the day we have Mass, which is June 21st students are required to wear clothes that are appropriate for Church. That means no shorts.

Some companies take several months to get the books here and some schools, that do not use BOCES, allow only one time ordering and they have a deadline.

The Final Exams are scheduled for students in 3rd and 5th grade and they will begin on Tuesday, June 13th. Check the school calendar for the test schedule. **All students and parents are reminded that the students are to be in school by 8:45 am each day.**

The date for the Pre-K and Kdgn. Graduation is Saturday, June 17th at 1:30 P.M. **The students are to be in school by 1:00 PM so they can get ready.** Pre-K students are to be in school each day until June 21st like the rest of the students. More information will come from Sr. Emilia and Sr. Chinedu.

Wednesday the 21st, we will have the Graduation Mass and awards. It will be at 9:30 AM. Mass will be followed by the awards presentation. This is the last day of school for this year.

The sisters ask God's blessing on all who helped, in any way, to make this an enjoyable year for everyone as well as all who worked on any fundraisers to help to keep our tuition affordable.

REMINDERS:

Please, take some time during the summer to help your child review the material they have learned during the year so they will be ready to begin next year. As always your help is greatly appreciated.

All tuition and fees should be paid in full by the end of May. Any outstanding tuition bills will be turned over for collection after the first of July.

We will have Summer School for Math & Reading as well as Summer Camp for grs. Pre-K to 5th Gr. from July 10th to Aug.3rd . For information and registration see the flyer or contact the school office. This is also open to students outside of our school as well

During the summer, please, continue to save your Big G cereal box tops. These can be turned in to the school in September.

We still have openings available in all grades for next year. If you know of anyone who has not yet registered their child or is looking for a new school, for next year, tell them about our school. Textbooks need to be ordered and some students have said they are returning but the forms were not turned in. These forms and all papers must be in with the fee paid before books can be ordered.

The recycling bin is located in the parking lot at the south end of the school. It is available all summer and you can drop off your unwanted papers at any time.
