Dear Parents:

Lent has begun on Wednesday, February 14th . Remember Jesus gave his ALL for us, we should show our love for Him by helping others.

Catholic Charities is one of the activities the church has to help others. Also poor children are helped through the Holy Childhood Association. The schools assist by raising money to help the poor. We have the collection boxes which each child has received and they can use their extra change or give up a snack or desert and put the money in the box to help the less fortunate in our area. These boxes will be returned to the school by Thursday, March 22nd.

The re-registration forms are going home next week. Due to the high cost of books and supplies it has become necessary to re-register all students each year. Therefore, students presently in Kdgn. – 4th Grade will receive the forms. For books to be ordered, the forms and the One Hundred Dollar (\$100.00) fee must be returned by Friday, March 16th . The \$100.00 re-registration fee assures your child's place for next year, and it will be credited toward your child's tuition in January of 2019. It should be understood that if for any reason your child does not attend the Villa for the 2018-2019 school year or leaves before the end of January 2019 the One Hundred Dollar (\$100.00) re-registration fee is non-refundable and it cannot be used to cover any outstanding tuition if you leave before the end of January 2019.

Parents of the Pre-Kindergarten students received the registration packet in January. **These forms and the \$50.00 non-refundable registration fee were due by January 26th.** For your child to be registered for 2018-2019 these forms must be returned and the fee paid. Also the tuition contract form must be filled out, signed, and returned. **Students going to Kindergarten must be registered before books are ordered for them. The district will not allow us to order books until we have the child registered and they have verified that the child is a resident of their district.** We will be ordering the books in April, and some schools do not allow books to be ordered after the initial deadline for ordering has past.

REMINDERS:

Parents are reminded that all students Pre- Kindergarten to 5th Grade are to come to school on time. They should be in school by 8:30 and be ready for class. Students should be properly dressed. Students who do not have the logo on their white polo shirts need to wear a vest with the logo. All shirts should be tucked into the pants, skirts, or blouses at all times.
